- 1. Minutes -The minutes of the last meeting held on 1st March 2007 were approved as a true record and signed by the Chairman. There were no matters arising.
- 2. Correspondence:-
- a. from Simon Dainty and Mark Jackson separate letters complaining that an Eathorpe team had fielded players who were in one case inappropriately strong and in the other inappropriately weak for the division concerned.
