

Week Commencing 2nd May 2005

Four excellent results for St. Georges A in Division 1 have put them at the top with 89 points from 10 wins and one draw. First Ian Packford, Mike Bishop and Earl Sweeney crushed RNA C in singles and Packford and Bishop the doubles for a 10-0 result. Then an 8-2 over County Council A, Ian Packford a treble, Earl Sweeney and Mike Bishop braces plus the doubles again from Packford and Bishop. Matthew Hobday replied for Council. Then they drew 5-5 with Whitnash B, Saints worst result, Earl Sweeney and Mike Bishop picking up braces and Pete Dasher a useful single whilst Whitnash's Alan Hewitt and Justin Rai held two each and the doubles. Whitnash A beat Colebridge B 8-2, Jon Williams and Mark Woolerton three each, Jane Dickens one and the doubles with Jon Williams. Mike Rinnhofer and Navinder Matharu kept one each for Colebridge.
