

Week Commencing 17th December 2007

BGN's trio of Bob Harman, Gary Jackson and Jason Adams were in fine form as they ran up two 8-2 victories against Free Church's two Division 1 sides. Against Free Church A, Bob and Jason both won maximums, with Gary adding a brace. Gary Webb held on to a single for Free Church, then took the doubles with Hugh Matthews. Mike Bridgman and Chris Mulligan both picked up a single for Church B, but hat-tricks from Jackson and Adams, the doubles together, and a single from Harman completed the win. St Georges A overwhelmed Colebridge B 9-1 with three plus the doubles from Earl Sweeney and Matt Squires. Mike Bishop added two, with Muhammad Khalid consoling for 'Bridge.

In Division 2, AP Sports A showed plenty of killer instinct as they hammered Eathorpe A 10-0. Andy Meredith, Ed Freeman and Terry Smith taking the points. It was tougher for AP against Rugby C and the two sides battled out a 5-5 draw. Andy Meredith and Sam Apostol won one each, Terry Smith two and the doubles went to Terry and Andy. For Rugby, Matthew Outhwaite won an excellent maximum; Dave Daniels two.

Jack Koumi won another two for Rugby and took the doubles with Marion Dixon. Reg Warnes won three for WCC, Graham Roberts and Sue Clarke two each.

In Division A, Eathorpe D beat AP Sports B 4-1 thanks to two from Charles Wragg, one from Peter Nicholson and the doubles from the pair. Tony Williams collected a consolation for AP. Free Church J beat Division B opponents Eathorpe F 4-1 as Scott Delday won his two and took the doubles with Lindy Myers, who also won once. Richard Freeman held on to a point for 'Thorpe. Eathorpe I beat LCP Packers 4-1 – William Hancock won two, Liz Hancock one and the pair also took the doubles. Nicky Barrett won one for LCP. Free Church K also beat LCP Packers 4-1, this time with Doug Smith earning the consolation point. For Church, Anita Whitehouse won her two, Jack Hobbins one and the pair took the doubles. Harbury Lane A cruised past Free Church N – Sam and Alex Twigg winning singles and doubles in a 5-0 win. Eathorpe G were also 5-0 winners when they played Eathorpe H. Ryan Oldham and Dave Hawker doing the damage. A final 5-0 win went to Free Church L, as Sam

and Tom Smith showed no mercy when defeating Free Church M.

Division C side, Free Church Q, fought hard for their 4-1 win over Free Church R. Simon Thompson won twice for Q, David Marguerie once and the pair took the doubles. Simon Thompson held a single for Q, then took the doubles with Jeremy Knott. Snitterfield B won 3-2 against Eathorpe K, with Paula Clayton winning a brace and taking the doubles with Anne Kilbee. Jonathan and Richard Milton both won once each in reply for 'Thorpe. Eathorpe L won a close encounter with Free Church T as Conor Thorpe won an excellent brace, then joined James Hobbs to take the doubles. Lauren Delday and Lucy Marlow both kept a point in reply. Eathorpe K beat Eathorpe J 4-1 with Richard Milton winning twice, Jonathan Milton once and the pair combining for the doubles. Jordain Cullaine-Liburd held one for J. Eathorpe J then found Snitterfield B too strong as Kevin and Richard Bennett rolled them over 5-0. Rugby H were 3-2 winners over Eathorpe K as Daniel Roberts steered them to victory with a maximum plus doubles with Billy Kyle. Richard and Jonathan Milton both kept one in reply. Free Church P were comfortable 4-1 winners over Free Church S. Chris Beckett won his two, James Payne one and then the pair took the doubles. Tom Boote was the S side's lone victor.
